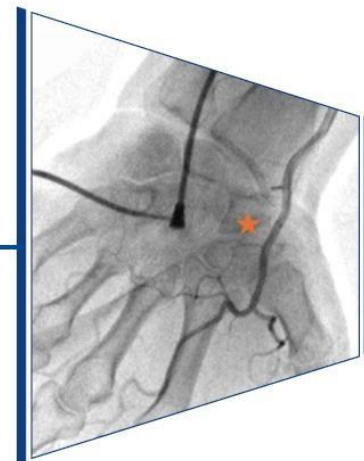

- **application** of new technologies and solutions in medicine.

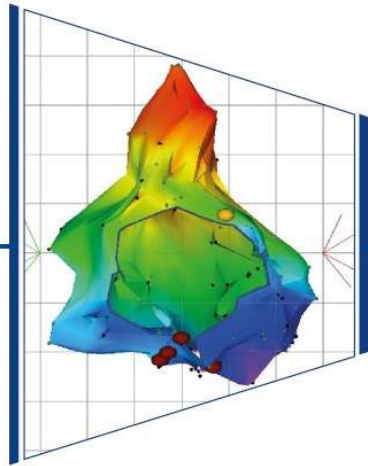

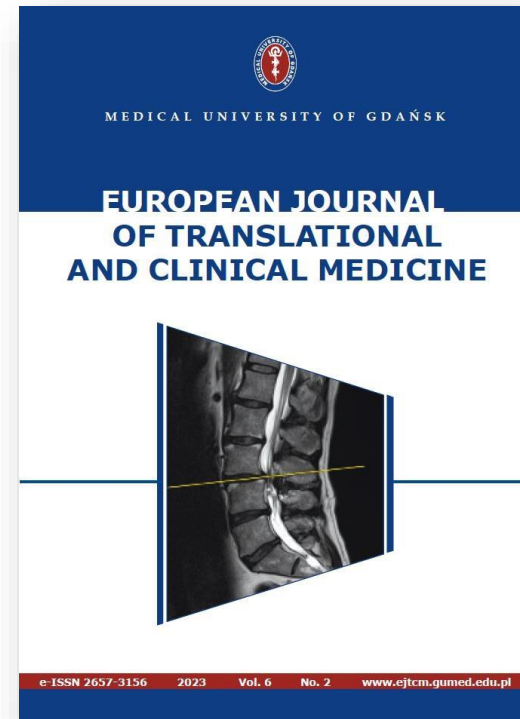
